touch-up paint

Keep away from children

Touch-up paint can only be used for lacquers, never for a stain finish.
The touch-up paint is a different system than the original, so differences will occur.
Only apply the paint at room temperature.

1. degrease the spot.
2. shake the paint well so that you can hear the ball rattle.
3. unscrew the cap, there is a brush attached.
4. brush off any excess paint that runs back into the bottle.
5. paint the spot.
6. use a toothpick for very small spots.
7. let it dry.
